Re: Recycling Drop of Facility

Due to Lycoming County and Lycoming County Resource Management temporarily suspending recycling until April 1, 2020 effective Immediately for its drop off facilities,

Lewis Township will also be temporarily suspending its recycling drop off facility until April 1, 2020 effective immediately March 18, 2020. (Date may be extended due to changing developments regarding Coronavirus (COVID-19)).

The Drop Off Boxes will be locked at the Lewis Township site. Please do not leave any material at the site, as this would be considered illegal dumping. You have the option to hold onto your recyclables until April 1, 2020. Or to throw them away.

Do not leave ANY materials at the recycling site. That is illegal dumping and littering.
