

Lewis Township Supervisors  
Work Session/ Meeting  
October 24, 2017

A work session/meeting of the Lewis Township Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Willard Murray at 10:30 A.M. at the Lewis Township building. Those also present were Supervisors Duane M. Blakeney and Jay Douglas Bomberger, Solicitor Benjamin Landon, Secretary/Treasurer Lucinda R. Bomberger, Eric Moore from West Branch Regional Authority and Linda Sterling from Seda Cog.

Linda Sterling from Seda-Cog attended the meeting to speak to the Supervisors about a CDBG Competitive Grant Opportunity for the Schell and Koch Road Sewer Project in detail and all that would entail in preparing the application and decisions that would need to be made. The Grant would be for \$775,000.00. Linda recommended pursuing the June 2018 Application. It was decided to move forward with Door to Door Surveys to determine the low to moderate income status of the residents in the Schell and Koch road service area through the month of November. The outcome of the survey will determine if the Township is eligible to apply for the grant. Linda Sterling will be attending the December Supervisors meeting.

**Old Business**

A motion was made by Duane M. Blakeney, seconded Jay Douglas Bomberger and passed to appoint Eric Staman as a member of the Lewis Township Planning Commission term ending December 31, 2019.

**New Business**

Discussion was held regarding the 2018 Budget for Wastewater Operation and General Funds. Discussion included the possible need for an increase of the sewer rate for wastewater operations and also to levy an equipment tax for capital reserve.
