

Lewis Township Supervisors
Regular Monthly Meeting
July 1, 2020

The Lewis Township Regular Monthly Meeting was called to order by Vice-Chairman Ricky Dyer at 4:00 P.M. at the Lewis Township building. Those also present were Supervisor Thomas J Marshall, Solicitor Jonathan Dewald, Secretary/Treasurer Lucinda R. Bomberger and six guests.

A motion was made Thomas Marshall, seconded by Ricky Dyer and passed to approve the minutes from the Supervisors regular monthly meeting on June 3, 2020 as written.

The June Financial Reports approval was tabled until the August 2020 meeting.

Supervisors

Ricky Dyer reported that Supervisor/Roadmaster Willard Murray was not present at the meeting due to tar and chipping of the roads, Robbins, Schuyler, Warrior Run Blvd. North and portions of Laidacker.

Secretary/Treasurer

Secretary/Treasurer Lucinda R Bomberger reported that audits were complete and that copies of the 2019 Financial Statement was provided in the Supervisors meeting packets for their records.

Treatment Plant Operator

Jeff Silverling from West Branch Regional Authority reported that and DEP Inspection occurred on June 22, 2020 and there were no violations.

Fire Board Representative

Representative Ricky Dyer shared the May 2020 Fire Report submitted Chief Funk. Rick will be attending the July meeting if still scheduled.

Planning Commission

Lucinda R. Bomberger, recording secretary, reported the motion made by the Planning Commission regarding the Hoover Subdivision. Conditional approval was recommended based on DEP approval of the Sewage Facilities Module.

Also, Lucinda submitted recommendations of changes to the Lewis Township Zoning Ordinance that the Planning Commission has considered over the past six months of this year.

Solicitor Jonathan Dewald will move forward with the text of the Lewis Township Zoning Ordinance and submit to the Lewis Township Planning Commission and Northumberland County Planning Commission.

New Business

A motion was made by Thomas J Marshall, seconded by Ricky Dyer and passed to approve the Hoover Subdivision with condition of PA DEP approval of the Sewage Facilities Module.

A motion was made by Ricky Dyer, seconded by Thomas J Marshall and passed to appoint Thomas J Marshall to the Lewis Township Planning Commission.

A motion was made by Ricky Dyer, seconded by Thomas J Marshall and passed to approve a proposal submitted by HRG to prepare NPDES Permits Applications for the Lewis Township Wastewater Treatment Plant and Lewis Township Five Points Small Flow Treatment Plant in the amount of \$7,750.00.

Approval of a waiver request submitted Renewal Processing: Appendix A, III, B.6 of the Lewis Township Stormwater Ordinance was tabled until the August 2020 meeting.

A motion was made by Ricky Dyer, seconded by Thomas J Marshall and passed to approve Engagement of Services with Herring, Roll & Solomon for Fiscal Year 2021 for Township and Tax Collection in the Amount \$5,500.00.

A motion was made by Thomas J Marshall, seconded by Ricky Dyer and passed to authorize payment of Invoices from New Enterprise Stone & Lime, Co. to be paid from the Lewis Township State Fund:

Public Comment

Lee Bieber inquired when the Township would address the drain pipe installed at the time of the Wolfe Blvd. project last year. Lee has asked numerous times for it to be fixed and still has not been done. Supervisor Dyer said that he would look into it. Lee also wanted something done to the stones that interfere with his mowing.

Harris Menges made a request to the Supervisors that they would please see to it that Warrior Run School District take care of their own stormwater run-off with the current Land Development that has been submitted for consideration. Stormwater from the front of the school district currently is draining through his farmland adjacent to the school and it has no where to go but lay in his field. He would like the school district to plan to take care of their own water.

A motion was made by Thomas J Marshall, seconded by Ricky Dyer and passed to adjourn the meeting at 4:26 PM.
