A motion was made by Jay Douglas Bomberger, seconded by Duane M. Blakeney and passed to approve the Moses Yoder Land Development Plan and Waiver Request regarding Section III.B.3 regarding the minimum 2' projection of the proposed anti-seep collar with the following contingencies:

1. The review engineer's approval of the verbal waiver request submitted by R. K. Webster, waiving Article III Section 1.4.5 of the Lewis Township Stormwater Management Ordinance regarding infiltration/groundwater recharge of the increase in volume of the 2-year storm event. Randy suggested there is ideal opportunity for the required run off to be infiltrated and/or used by existing vegetation. The existing vegetation may not be disturbed or made impervious.
2. The approved waiver requests be noted on the plans.
3. Signatures were authorized upon the contingencies being met.
